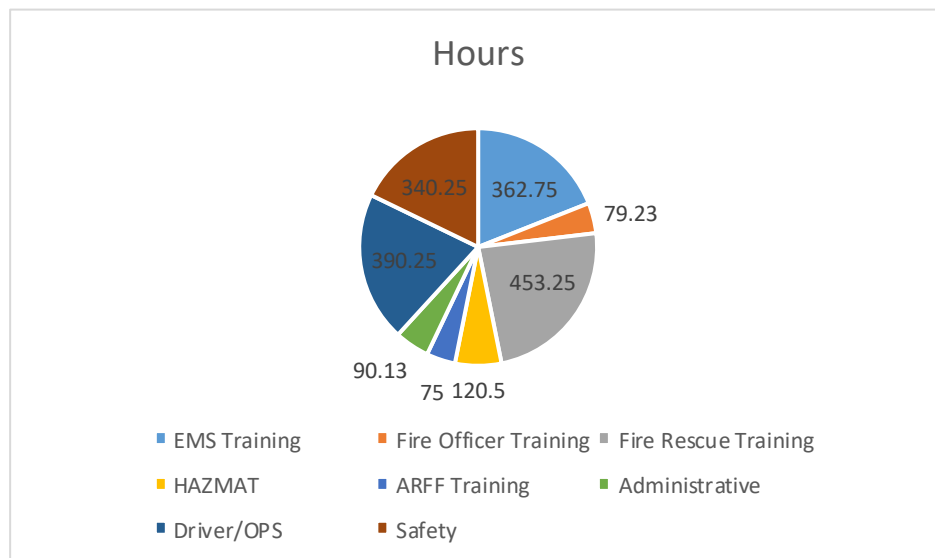


Fire Department Training Report for July, 2017

For the month of July 2017 the fire department held training which totaled 1911.36 hours. The training topics have been grouped into eight categories. They are Administrative, ARFF, Driver/Operator, EMS, Fire/Rescue, Safety, Hazmat, and Officer. The chart below represents the proportion of training held in these eight categories for the month of July.
