All leagues feature a minimum10-week schedule and a <u>single-elimination</u> tournament at the end of the season. **Entry fee is \$400 per team.** Note: No refunds will be issued after league schedules have been completed *(end of March)*.

All leagues follow rules of the Amateur Softball Association (ASA) and feature two registered ASA umpires for each game.

An informational meeting will be held **Tuesday**, **February 20, 2018 at 7:00 pm at Lincoln Leisure Center** and will include information regarding registration procedures, league format and rule updates.

General Information

1. Playing fields: O'Neil (900 N. Hinshaw)

Pepper Ridge West (2502 Fox Creek Road)

- 2. Twenty-player maximum on rosters.
- 3. Rainouts will be made-up at the end of the season, added into weeknight schedule, or on Sundays when necessary.
- 4. Players may play on more than one team, but must play in the same league classification and only on 1 roster per league. For example: All Rec B players may play in any of the Rec B leagues, but only on one team per league.
- 5. Team award to first and second place teams in League play. Tournament award to top team.
- 6. League Classification:

Rec C: Purely recreational teams with very little playing experience; must be a returning team (50% of roster, minimum 7 players) with three or less wins in previous season. No home runs allowed.

Rec B: Recreational teams with some playing experience: lower levels of play; no homerun hitters; no ASA

tournament players; team which won Rec C league.

Recreational teams yet of a higher level of play than B, players with more experience; may have a

few homerun hitters; teams which have won Rec B league title 2 consecutive years

7. With a six team league, games are played at 7:00 pm, 8:00 pm, and 9:00 pm.

Registration Information

Roster forms may be picked up at the information meeting, at the office after the meeting, or at our website (www.bloomingtonparks.org) after February 8. Signed roster forms are due by April 10.

All teams will register March 12 - 22. Registration options include online, mail, fax and drop off (at the Bloomington Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts office, 115 E Washington Street). The league fee is due upon registration. Registration forms can be found online at www.bloomingtonparks.org. **Season begins the week of May 7**.



- Go to our our NEW website BloomingtonParks.org
- Click on the Register button located at the upper right corner of your screen
- Top right hand corner hit "Create Household Account"
- Fill in all information listing PRIMARY contact first
- Your email address is required and becomes your "User Name"
- ✓ Create your own password noting the password requirements
- After password verification add all additional household members by clicking "Add Member"
- Fill out all necessary information for each household member and click on "Continue" and "Add Member" until entire household is added for your household
- Hit "submit" when finished. You will be logged in and can begin to register!







After you set up your account... This is How To Register for a Program

- Login
- · Go to Registration Tab
- Select Activity Registration
- · You can search under "Category"
- Or go to Advanced Search to narrow down your options
- Choose your Category and click on the black triangle next to what you have chosen
- · All programs for that category will appear
- · Locate the program you want to register for
- Select the program and click on the "Register" button on the left hand side
- · After you register you will be advanced to the next screen
- · All Activity Information will appear in the first box
- "Registrant Information" will be available in the second box
- Select the participant that you want to register in the drop down box next to the Astryks labeled "Name of Registrants"
- Click "Add to Cart" at the bottom of the box
- If you are finished go to the "Checkout Box" on the right hand side and complete your transaction
- If you want to register for more than 1 program click "Continue Shopping" on the left hand side and repeat the process until you are finished then go to the "Checkout Box" on the right hand side and complete your transaction
