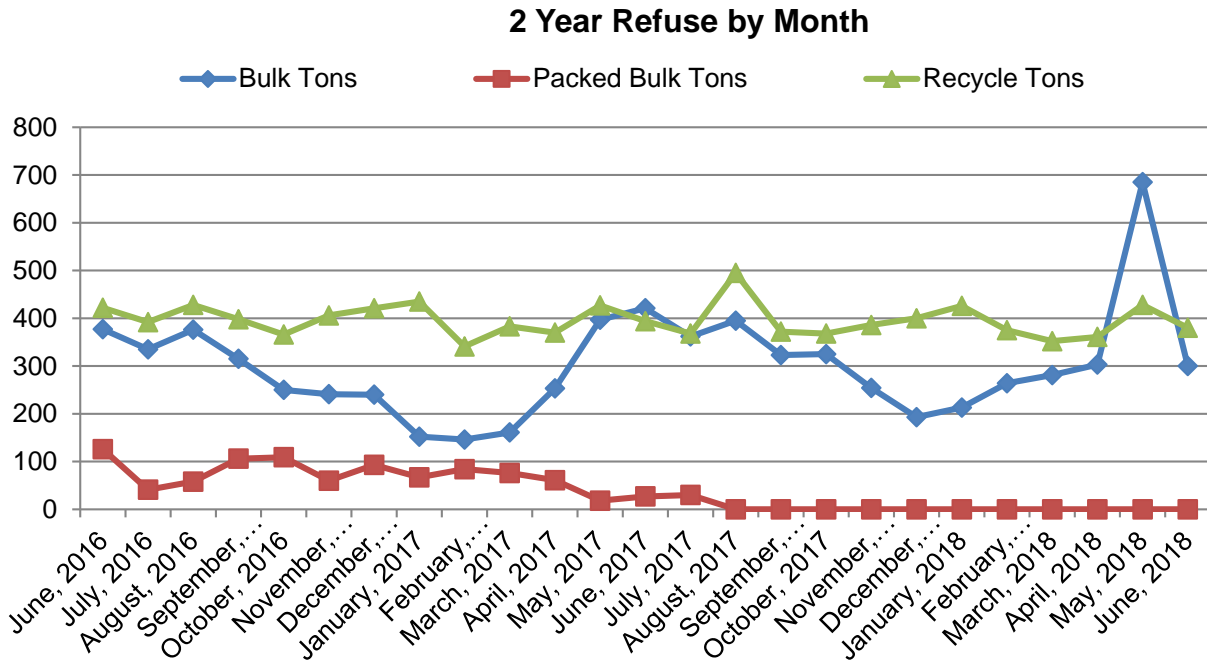

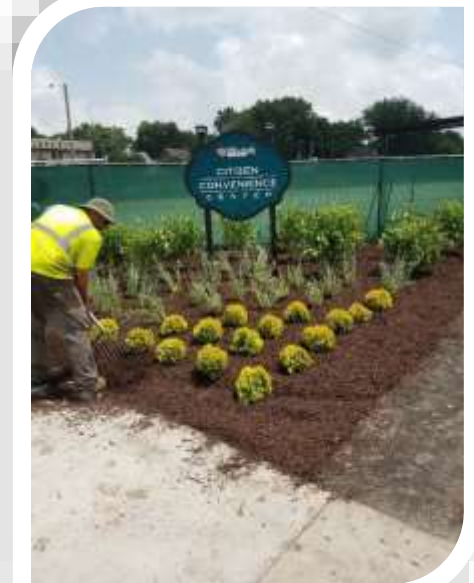

## PUBLIC WORKS CITIZEN CONVENIENCE CENTER

The Citizen Convenience Center enables people who participate in the Solid Waste Program to bring their items to a central location for processing rather than waiting for collection. This service was provided free of charge beginning May 1, 2018.

The Public Works Department has been working diligently to make the Citizens Convenience Center (previously named Drop-Off Facility), more efficient and accommodating for our Citizens. The CCC has expanded its operation hours this summer from 6 AM to 8 PM (Monday-Fridays) and 7 AM to 3 PM (Saturdays).
