Shots Fired Incident

Bloomington, IL –On Tuesday, 07/26/22, at 6:52 pm., Bloomington Police officers were dispatched to the 100 block of N. Williamsburg Drive, for a shots fired call. Upon arrival, witnesses observed subject (s) running from the area. Officers located a 17-year-old Normal Illinois male near an apartment complex. During a discussion with the juvenile male, a pistol was observed in his pants pocket. Officers removed the pistol and placed the juvenile male in custody without incident.

The 17-year-old male was arrested for:

- UNLAWFUL USE OF A WEAPON
- AGGRAVATED DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM

No other information will be release about the juvenile.
