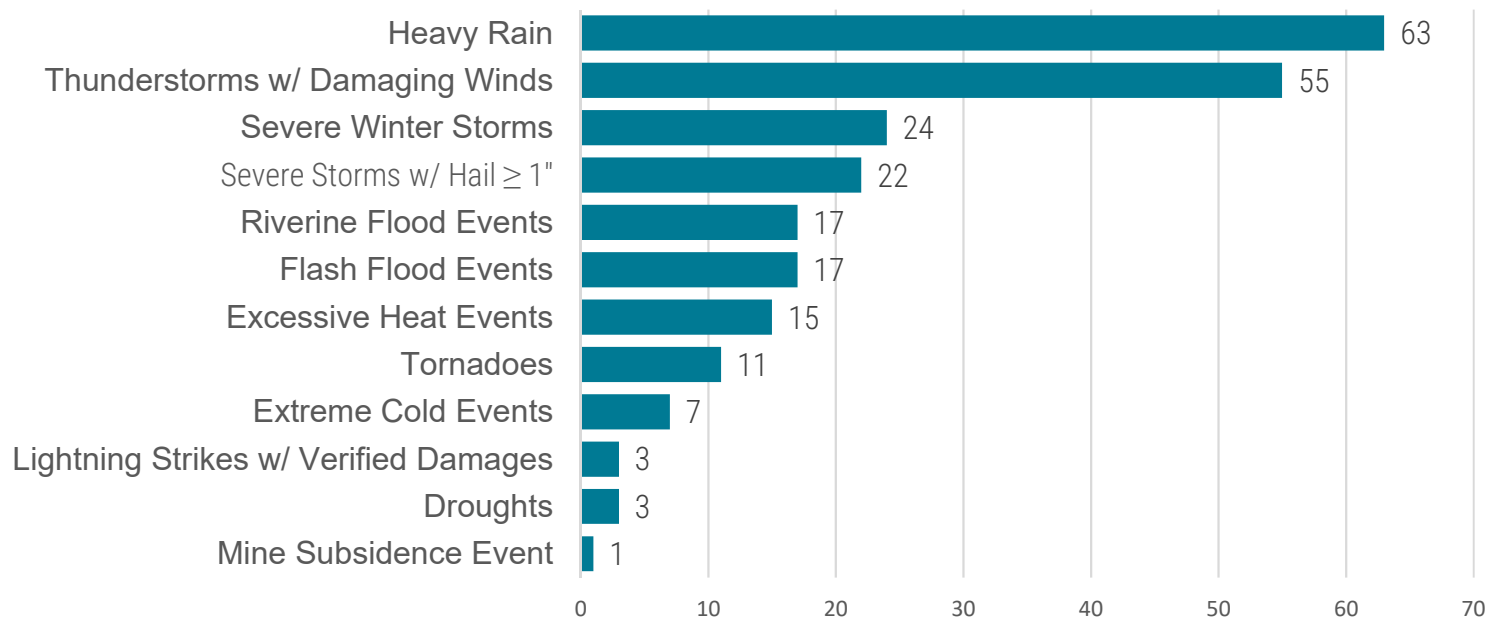


## WHAT IS HAZARD MITIGATION PLANNING?
