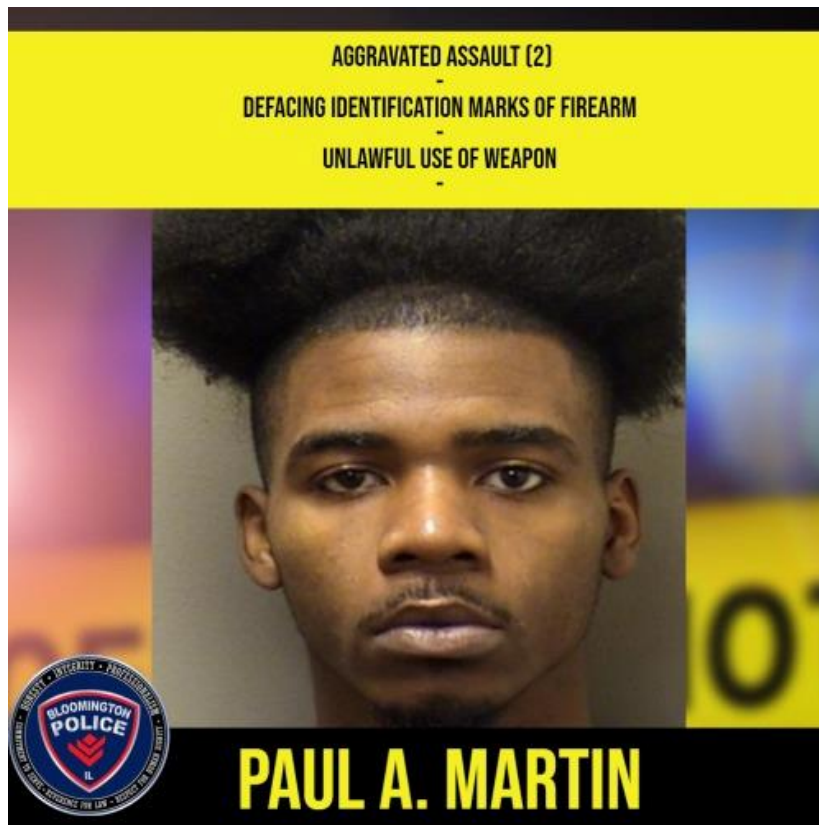
As the investigation continued, it was determined an unknown person(s) had shot at a male subject. The male subject returned fire and was identified as Paul Martin. As the investigation continued, Martin, 20, of Bloomington was arrested.

Martin was charged with:

UNLAWFUL USE OF WEAPON
