
Market Street (MLK Drive to Hinshaw Avenue)

- New 8' sidewalks on both sides








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


Locust Street (Hinshaw Avenue to Lee Street)

- ♦ Existing sidewalk with new ramps at crosswalks








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


Empire Street (Lee St. to Colton Ave.) & Locust St. (Main St. to Robinson St.)

- ♦ Parking lane








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
Typical Section #4


Empire St. (Colton Ave. to Towanda Ave.) & Locust St. (Robinson St. to Colton Ave.)

- Right sidewalk new with ramps at crosswalks








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


Empire Street (Towanda Avenue to Carnahan Drive)





- Four traffic lanes (two-way)
