Crews will collect bulk at no additional charge for Solid Waste Program customers from **October 7** to **October 18**. Crews will follow the 2024 Leaf, Brush, Trimmings, & Bulk Pickup Calendar, starting with **Zone 1 Orange** on **October 7**. Leaves, brush, and trimmings will be picked up at the same time as bulk. Pickup dates may be adjusted, depending on the amount of material, weather, and other factors. Public Works will post regular updates and update the interactive map at www.bloomingtonil.gov/solidwaste as crews progress. Materials must be placed in separate piles behind the curb by 6:00 a.m. on the date shown on daily updates.

Solid Waste customers may take leaves, brush, trimmings, and bulk to the Citizen Convenience Center located at 402 S. East Street in Bloomington (south of the Bloomington Public Library). The center is open from 7 a.m. to 2:45 p.m. Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday; 7 a.m. to 10:45 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. to 2:45 p.m. Saturday; and 11 a.m. to 6:45 p.m. Wednesday. It is closed on Sunday, Monday, and holidays. Regular household trash and Household Hazardous Waste are **not** accepted at the center.

ACCEPTABLE

LEAVES

- Leaves only

GARDEN TRIMMINGS

- Flowers
- Plants
- Fruit trimmings
- Vegetable trimmings
- Pumpkins

BRUSH

- Trees
- Shrubs
- Bushes

BULK

- Furniture
- Items of waste generated by cleaning out a house (other than food waste)
- Basement, interior, and exterior remodeling debris (permit may be required)

UNACCEPTABLE

- Extreme demolitions (i.e., an entire garage or floor)
- Household garbage (i.e., food waste or food containers)
- Commercial or hazardous waste (i.e., paint, varnish, oils, chemicals, tires, or automobile batteries)
- Dirt, sod, or any other waste that includes dirt
- Other Waste, including appliances*, electronics, grass and thatch clippings, propane tanks, concrete*, rock*, shingles*, and brick*

**These materials can be collected curbside during the free bulk pickup, but customers must call Public Works at 309-434-2225 for an estimate and to schedule a pickup. The materials must be free of dirt.*
