Arrest Made in Burglary Investigation

Bloomington, IL - On 10/28/24, after an investigation by the Bloomington Police Department, an arrest warrant was issued for Jamaude Tutwiler. The arrest warrant contained fourteen charges related to several area vehicle burglaries. The burglaries involved the theft of various items, including firearms and credit cards.

On 10/31/24, members of the BPD Street Crimes Unit and patrol officers located Tutwiler in the area of Morris Avenue and Goose Creek Drive. Tutwiler was arrested without incident. Tutwiler was transported to the McLean County Detention Facility, where he remains in custody.

- Armed habitual criminal
- Unlawful use of weapons/felon possess/use firearm prior (2 counts)
- Burglary (3 counts)
- Possession of a firearm with no FOID
- Burglary without causing damage (2 counts)
- Unlawful possession of a credit or debit card (2 counts)
- Use of a forged credit or debit card (3 counts)
