

**Nomination for the 2017
Bloomington Human Relations Commissions
Adult Human Relations Award**

The Bloomington and Normal Human Relations Commissions have established this award to recognize the achievements of individuals who have made outstanding contributions in human relations in the City of Bloomington and the Town of Normal.

Nomination Criteria - Who is Eligible

- 0 The nominee must be a resident of Bloomington or Normal.
- 1 The activity for which the individual is being nominated must be not-for-profit and not a part of the individual's work related duties.
- 2 Self nominations will not be accepted.
- 3 Bloomington and Normal Human Relations Commissioners, staff, family members and past awardees are ineligible to receive the award.

Selection Criteria

- 4 A demonstrated commitment to improving cooperation and fostering mutual respect among people of different racial, ethnic, religious and other backgrounds.
- 5 Use of new and creative measures to fight discrimination, prejudice and the effects of past discrimination.

Nomination Process

- 6 Complete the nomination form. *Nominations will be judged solely on the responses to questions on the nomination form; no supporting materials will be accepted.*
